

CALL FOR GRANT APPLICATIONS (AE2021-0088)

INESC TEC is now accepting grant applications to award 1 Research Grant (BI) within the scope of the project NEWSAT, cofunded by the ERDF - European Regional Development Fund, through the Programa Operacional Regional do Norte (NORTE 2020) and by National Funds through the FCT - Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P. on the scope of the MIT Portugal Program on the scope of NORTE-01-0247-FEDER-045918

1. GRANT DESCRIPTION

Type of grant: Research Grant (BI)

General scientific area: PHYSICS

Scientific subarea:

Grant duration: 12 months, starting on 2021-07-01, with the possibility of being renewed until the end of the project.

Scientific advisor: Susana Alexandra Barbosa

Workplace: INESC TEC, Porto, Portugal

Maintenance stipend: € 1104,64, according to the table of monthly maintenance stipend for FCT grants (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), paid via bank transfer. Grant holders may be awarded potential supplements, according to a quarterly evaluation process (Articles 19, 21 and 22 of the Regulations for Grants of INESC TEC and Annex II), up to a maximum limit of 50% of the monthly maintenance stipend.

Costs attributable to INESC TEC may include registration, enrolment or tuition fee stipend, either directly or through reimbursement, during the grant duration.

The grant holder will benefit from health insurance, supported by INESC TEC.

2. OBJECTIVES:

The proposed training is in the scope of the Activity 3 of the project (Science and development of new knowledge), specifically the task on "Earth observation data analytics" enabling the applicant to acquire knowledge and experience in the management and analysis of data from ionospheric sensors. Specific objectives include:

- Increase knowledge on the state of art of satellite ionospheric data collection and management
- Develop research skills and the ability to evaluate research results;
- Develop the ability to select appropriate methods and analysis strategies;

3. BRIEF PRESENTATION OF THE WORK PROGRAMME AND TRAINING:

- Definition and implementation of strategies for management of satellite ionospheric data;
- Programming of algorithms for processing of mass spectrometry and plasma measurements;
- Participation in writing scientific papers;
- Writing of the grant report;

4. REQUIRED PROFILE:

Admission requirements:

Master in Data science, Physics, or similar

The awarding of the fellowship is dependent on the applicants' enrolment in study cycle or non-award courses of Higher Education Institutions.

Preference factors:

Experience in the analysis of geomagnetic data and/or ionospheric observations. Background in space instrumentation. Knowledge in programming in R and/or python. Fluency in English and Portuguese (spoken and written).

Minimum requirements:

Master degree classification above 14

5. EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS AND SELECTION PROCESS:

Selection criteria and corresponding valuation: the first phase comprises the Academic Evaluation (AC), based on the criteria referred to in Article 12 of the Regulations for Grants of INESC TEC, while the second phase comprehends the Individual Interview (EI). All factors are evaluated on a scale of 0 to 100, taking into account the applicants' merit, suitability and conformity with the preference factors.

The weight of the AC factors are as follows: Academic Qualifications (FA, 30%), Scientific Publications (PC, 25%), Experience (EX, 25%) and Motivation Letter (CM, 20%).

Candidates who score less than 50 points in the AC average will be considered excluded on absolute merit. The top five candidates approved on absolute merit will be qualified for the individual interview. The Final Grade (CF) is obtained by the weighted average of AC (80%) and EI (20%).

Release of results and prior hearing: the results of the selection process, as well as the terms and procedures for prior hearing, will be released to the applicants by email, under the terms referred to in Article 13 of the Regulations for Studentships and Fellowships of INESC TEC.

6. FORMALISATION OF APPLICATIONS:

Application Documents:

1. Motivation letter;
2. Curriculum Vitae (must include the list of previous fellowships, their type, beginning and end dates, funding entities and host institutions);
3. Certificate or diploma degree fully recognised in Portugal;
 - Documents proving the awarding of academic degrees and diplomas, or the according recognition - in cases of academic degrees or diplomas granted by a foreign higher education institution - can be dismissed in the application process, and replaced by the applicant's declaration of honour, with the verification of said condition taking place during the grant's hiring stage. The submission of the certificate is mandatory when signing the contract.
 - Academic degrees or diplomas awarded by a foreign higher education institution require an authentication by a Portuguese higher education institution, and the corresponding registration on the DGES platform, in conformity with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16, and Ordinance no. 33/2019, of January 25. 4. Proof of enrollment in a degree awarding study cycle or in a non degree awarding Higher Education program.
 - The proof of enrollment may be presented just during the grant hiring stage.
5. Signed declaration stating the infringement of the grant holder's duties (article 14, no. 4)
6. Documental evidence to support the country of residence, residence permit or other legally equivalent document, in cases where the applicant is a foreigner or non-resident in Portugal - valid until the beginning of the grant.
7. Other supporting documents relevant to the final assessment.

Failure to deliver the required documents within the 90-day period after the date of the notice of the conditional awarding of the grant implies its cancellation.

Application period: From 2021-05-12 to 2021-05-26

Submission of applications: the application will be formalised by submitting the form available in the *Work With Us* section of INESC TEC website.

7. BINDING LEGISLATION AND REGULATION
